Disinfecting Procedures—underway since January 29, 2020 in all schools

In addition to our normal cleaning routines, custodial staff are now disinfecting touch points and surfaces daily using a spray bottle and wiping down with a microfiber cloth that is laundered daily, or using a Victory Electrostatic Sprayer in all buildings at MCSSSD.

Examples of touch points in schools:

- Classroom desks;
- Lunchroom tables;
- Door handles and push plates;
- Handrails;
- Kitchen and bathroom faucets;
- Light switches;
- Athletic Equipment;
- Buttons on vending machines and elevators;
- Telephone handsets;
- Shared computer keyboards and mice; and
- Bus seats and handrails.

Disinfecting is the responsibility of school custodial staff. They are trained to use disinfectants in a safe and effective manner.

All schools will be deep cleaned this week, and schools will then be deep cleaned again 4 days prior to resumption of classes.
